### Additional information:

#### What to Wear:

- Generally, your child should wear informal and comfortable clothing.



- Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes are required, an extra change of clothes and shoes is required.
- For sun protection, wearing a hat is recommended. Children are required to bring sunscreen daily. Please label everything with your child's name on it.

#### What to Pack for Lunch

- Bring a sack lunch daily with your child's name printed on it.
- A filled water bottle is recommended.
- Please enjoy sweets and sodas at home.
- Polish Academy Houston will provide snacks but your child may bring their own snacks from home.
- Please make sure to note all food allergies and sensitivities to the staff.
- Polish Academy Houston reserves the right to make adjustments to the snack menu as needed.

## Summer Camp Policies and Procedures



- \$20 registration fee and \$150 deposit required till May 5th.
- The camp must be fully paid two weeks before it starts.
- Camp can be paid by check, Zelle, or Venmo transfer.
- NO deductions for the camp missed, regardless of attendance or holidays.
- Deposit and payments ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
- There is a return check charge of \$25.
- \$30 discount for additional family members and for "Polish Academy" students
- Additional \$25 fee for late pickup.

#### **Attendance:**

- Students must arrive on time for camp.
- Students under 18 must be picked up promptly after camp.
- Students are encouraged to attend camp regularly.



**Authorization to Pick-Up Child:**

Only persons that you authorized in writing may pick up your child. If someone else is picking up your child, please notify us in writing.

**Photographs/Video Photos (and rarely video)** are taken on a regular basis and are used only as promotional material for the Polish Academy Houston programs. At no time will a child's name be used in the promotional material. By signing this parent form the parent/guardian is giving the Polish Academy Houston permission for the child to be photographed/videotaped.

**Polish Academy Houston Philosophy of Discipline:**

We feel that positive discipline is a form of love and builds self-esteem. Discipline ensures that each participant's experience will be positive. We use the following forms of discipline, depending on the circumstances, the severity of the behavior, and frequency of occurrence: redirection, time-out, offering limited choices, positive reinforcement, one-on-one conferences, parent conferences, behavior charts, and parent pick-up. Minor discipline problems will be handled at the program site. If behavioral problems persist, we will contact the parent to discuss the situation. If a child's behavior is unsafe or harmful to themselves or another, the parent will be notified. No refunds are given in the event of removal from the program. Your help in keeping us informed on significant changes or events in your child's life that might impact his/her behavior would be appreciated. Please keep your emergency phone numbers and information up to date.

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

- Please NO chewing gum and eat in the classroom, unless it is eating time.
- Please do NOT leave food or drinks in the classroom.
- Please do NOT allow children to run in the hallway.
- Polish Academy will be closed if Houston ISD closes for inclement weather.
- Polish Academy in Houston is not responsible for items left unattended.
